Prayer Walking Neighborhoods

- Praying Onsight with Insight -

As we walk through a neighborhood or past a business, we bless people and ask God to reveal himself to the people who live or work in that area. We pay special attention to what we see, hear, and experience, allowing the Holy Spirit to guide our prayers together. We are asking for breakthroughs for families, workers, students, employers and teachers to be able to respond to the Holy Spirit's calling and conviction in their lives. We are saturating the neighborhood with prayer so that people will realize who Jesus is.

We are low profile so as not to stir up any unnecessary confrontations. We are trying to be good neighbors who think relationally and spiritually.

Be careful to represent Christ and New Hope in the best possible way.

- Please do not trespass on personal property.
- Be respectful and low-key as you pray so as not to draw attention.
- Go two-by-two so that you can talk and pray (and not look weird).
- > Ask the Lord to send laborers with us into the harvest field and for the opportunity to share the gospel with people who are ready to hear and ripe to receive.

Luke 10:2 He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

> Agree with the Spirit of the Lord who has come upon you and anointed you to proclaim good news...

Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners.

Pray for the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to come upon our region so that the people of our region will come to know God better.

Ephesians 1:17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

> Pray that the Lord would break the spirit of segregation between races, socio-economic classes, and even the physical boundaries of our city.

Malachi 2:10 Are we not all children of the same Father? Are we not all created by the same God? Then why do we betray each other,

> Pray that the Father would draw people to Jesus through all kinds of ways—family, media, friends at work, and school, even crises, etc...

John 6:44 "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day."

> Ask for the Spirit of Adoption to come upon the people of our region so that they would cry out, "Abba" Father.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

- > Pray for people to have their eyes opened to see the light of the Gospel that penetrates the darkness of the age we live in.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.
